

Before you begin editing:

1. Make a **folder** on the External Drive with your name and period.
2. Select three or more pieces of footage (at least **one must be downloaded from YouTube**) and save to your **folder**. Some suggested sites to use include: OnlineVideoConverter.com, y2mate.com, and Convertinmp4.com
3. Create a **new project file** in Adobe Premiere Pro and save to your **folder**.
4. Import the video footage into Adobe Premiere Pro.

Assignment:

Use all three clips to demonstrate the following skills. The video does not need to make sense.

- 1. Split a clip using the **razor tool** and insert another clip in the space
- 2. Add an **audio fade** in / fade out
- 3. Add a **video fade** in / fade out
- 4. Create a **still title** at the beginning
- 5. Add **scrolling credits** at the end
- 6. **Unlink audio and video** tracks on a clip and separate them or edit them separately
- 7. **Create a still image** from your video footage
- 8. **Add motion** to and/or **resize** the still image (Ken Burns effect)

To Submit:

- **Save** (Format: Last Name, First Initial, Period Number – Example: “**SmithJ p4**”) and then **Export** to the External Drive (follow the steps in the [Class Basics Handout](#))
- **Upload** to Google Drive
